

Report 2020-2021:

78 percent of students mentioned that 70 to 100% syllabus was covered in the class and most of the students (763) mentioned that teachers come prepared in the classrooms and 643 students mention that the communication of the teachers was good in the class. For teachers approach 450 students mark it "always effective" and internal evaluation process, 714 students think it is always or usually fair. Most of the students told that the "performance in assignments discussed" with them. 71% students told that 'institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students'. 82 % students mentioned that "teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth". 85 % students agrees with 'institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow'. 81% mentioned that they were told about 'expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes'. 80% students told that mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task with them. 88% students agrees with "teachers use illustration the concepts through examples and applications for teaching and teachers identify students strengths and encourage them with right level of challenges. Also 78% students told that 'teachers are able to identify their weaknesses and helps to overcome the weakness. 675 students believes that the institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process and also 88% students that the institute use student centric methods, for enhancing learning experiences. 86% students encourage, teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities. 672 students believes that Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work. On the other hand, 369 students mentioned that teachers use less ICT tools in the class rooms. 696 students believes that the overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good.


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?




4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as: -




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.






















